Short Term Rental Rules and Restrictions Aug 24, 2016

The following restrictions are in addition to any town, county, or state regulations.

- 1. Short term rentals are defined as the rental of a residence that is less than 30 days.
- 2. A member can rent their property up to seven days per month
- 3. A member can rent their property no more than one time per month in no more than six months of the year
- 4. A maximum number of short term rental days is 42 days per calendar year
- 5. The maximum number of persons occupying a short term rental is 8 persons
- 6. The customers of a short term rental are not allowed to use the common elements in the community
- 7. The customers of a short term rental must follow all existing EHR CCRs
- 8. The member offering short term rentals must provide their rental agreement to the BOD for review
- 9. The member offering short term rentals must provide the contacts of their property manager to the BOD
